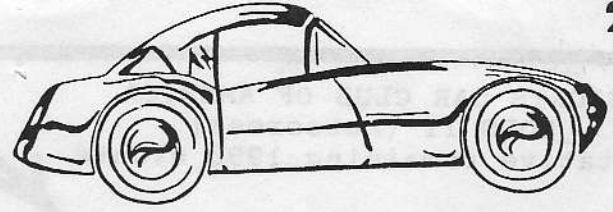

OK! What is the latest news on the new smog check regulations?? From a very reliable source direct from the BAR a vehicle is NOT considered a GROSS POLLUTER unless the tail pipe emissions are THREE times the allowed limits. It appears that almost any car can pass the new limits if it has and is maintained properly. Jerry Lanigan stated that according to the BAR it is possible for the smog check station to set up their machine for the new TRAINING MODE and do a tail pipe sniff which would not record data to the Sacramento control facility. It would be reasonable to assume that there would be a charge for this. Better start taking coffee and donuts to your favorite smog station.
